There may be additional requests and duties according to current needs at the discretion of the College Principal.
Attributes	 High energy levels; Strong communication skills; Keen interest in pedagogy and passion for Music; Experience with Orff approach and integrating written musical literacy; Strong organisational skills; Willingness to adopt new approaches / be flexible; and Leadership experience desirable.



Special Requirements	• Variable duties/hours. The nature of the position is such that this role requires the successful candidate to be available outside the "normal" school hours, to participate in the co-curricular music program.
